



Apply for funding of your research

The Mats F. and Catharina Linde Forsberg Foundation promotes scientific research, mainly regarding dog and domestic cat reproduction but also ethology and diseases related to reproduction in dogs and domestic cats.

The application must be made on the appropriate form. A detailed project description/project plan of maximum 12,000 characters including spaces is to be attached to the application form. This must contain the following:

Background

Purpose and hypothesis, overall and specific

Supplies and methods

Description of implementation

Timetable

Reference list

Short CV for all applicants including a list of publications on a maximum of two A4 pages (font at least 11 pt). CVs shall be attached to the application.

The application with attachments is sent by e-mail to the Foundation's secretary and must reach the Foundation by February 15 at the latest. Management fee may amount to a maximum of 10 % of the granted amount.

Animal experiments

Ethical permit must be approved if projects include animal experiments.

Review and decision

The applications are reviewed and assessed by the Foundation's Board and by persons with different special skills and solid knowledge in veterinary medicine and dog and cat reproduction, who are co-opted to the annual assessment meetings. The decisions are notified to applicants during the month of April.

Applicants who have not completed previous projects, or have not submitted a financial and scientific report within the set time **limit**, will not be granted money for new projects.

Publication

Results of research conducted with funding from the Foundation, in full or partially, shall be published as articles in scientific journals and/or as congress reports.
